## General Orders

No. 17.

1. The immediate and potent response to the mournful outcry of our stricken citizens in the fire swept district, by the Staff Departments, National Guard, Home Guard and the Motor Corps, impels the State of Minnesota to express profound appreciation and to convey to each officer and enlisted man, gracious thanks.

2. Understanding how little expressed gratitude means when your services were consecrated to the suffering and afflicted, by laboring at dreadful tasks for long periods of time, inattentive to personal health and comfort and heedless of personal risk; it is hereby ordered that there shall be written on the individual military record of every officer and enlisted man of the State military forces, who gave his services during the time of the fire and for relief work:

"Valorous services rendered during the forest fires in Northern Minnesota, October, 1918."

## RECOMMENDATIONS

The Adjutant General respectfully recommends:

1. The retention of the National Guard as such, in compliance with the act of Congress as detailed in bulletin 16, of the War Department, June 22, 1916.

(a) The reorganization into regiments, rather than battalions, and the retention of the Minnesota Home Guard and the Motor Corps and that there be an appropriation made which will adequately care for the maintenance and equipment of these troops; and further, that these troops be paid, when on active duty, the same rate that is paid the same rank in the National Guard; and further, that these troops be placed under the direction and command of the Adjutant General.

2. That the various armories in the state be placed under the direct supervision of the Adjutant General and by this means centralize the control.

3. That there be an officer detailed to act as Inspector General of the military forces of the state of Minnesota, whose duties shall be to make inspections which are deemed necessary.

4. That there be an officer detailed from this department to gather statistics regarding the part each man from Minnesota played in this world war, in order to supplement this report, which is admittedly not complete, owing to the fact that it is impossible to secure the desired data from the War Department, although several attempts have been made to secure such information.
