WHO MAY APPLY: Current members of the MN ARNG serving on AGR, in the rank of SGT/E-5 to SSG/E-6. Must have or be able to obtain 68W MOS. Eligibility is limited to personnel currently in the Minnesota Army National Guard who are serving on an Active Guard/Reserve (AGR) tour. Current AGRs must have a minimum of 18 months in the program to be eligible for reassignment.

REMARKS: PCS for current AGR's depends on funding. Upon selection, individual must be or become MOS/AOC qualified within twelve (12) months of appointment, except for deployed Soldiers, who will have an additional 12 months.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: This position is located at the battalion level. Responsible for tracking medical readiness and identifying the medical trends within the battalion. Coordinates all medical and dental events, tracks and assist Soldiers in the completion of the Periodic Health Assessments (PHA), administers vaccinations, track and process administrative separations for the battalion. Tracks and assists all medical evaluation boards and line of duty packets. Performs other duties as assigned. Must be qualified in DMOS or become qualified within the period prescribed in NGR 600-5.
